	Important: EU citizens do not pay for this procedure, but NON-EU citizens have
	to pay 350,00 kuna for the procedure and 240,00 kuna for the Temporary stay
	Card + 70,00 kn of tax money (total 660,00 kuna – approximately 90,00 euros)
	The official currency of the Republic of Croatia is Kuna (1 Kuna = 100 Lipa; 1
Living costs	EUR ~ 7.50 Kn).
