Location: University of Le Havre Normandy (Le Havre, France)

Working language: English (some French optional)

Eligibility: Open to students enrolled in one of the EUNICoast partner universities

Purpose of the internship

The selected intern will support the **EUNICoast communication strategy with a strong focus on students**, particularly through **social media (Instagram as a priority)** and **student-focused events**. The goal is to enhance the visibility of the Alliance among peers, strengthen student engagement, and bring forward fresh and creative ideas.

This position is best suited for someone **passionate about community management**, eager to connect with young audiences, and motivated to contribute creatively to both online and inperson student activities.

Main responsibilities

1. Social Media - Community Management and Content Creation

- Contribute to the editorial calendar and propose creative content ideas
- Create visual content and schedule engaging posts on Instagram
- Cover student events (photos, short videos, interviews)
- Monitor performance and suggest improvements based on engagement metrics

2. Student-to-Student Communication & Events

- Organize or co-organize student-focused activities at Université Le Havre Normandie (games, info sessions, meet-ups...)
- Support online events targeting students across the Alliance
- Collect and share testimonials from students involved in EUNICoast projects or mobilities
- Take part in awareness campaigns to promote the Alliance's opportunities

3. Occasional support

- Assist with communication logistics and campaigns
- Contribute to the EUNICoast newsletter with student-oriented content

- Strong knowledge of social media platforms, with a genuine interest in community management
- Experience in **content creation** using Canva, Adobe Creative Suite (Photoshop, Illustrator, Premiere Pro or equivalent), and digital communication tools. Ability to **produce visual assets** is required.
- Good communication skills in English (written and spoken) (some French optional)
- Creative, dynamic, and motivated to propose new ideas
- Organised, reliable, and proactive
- Interest in student life, European cooperation, and teamwork
